All riders that are current financial members of Dressage Waikato, Morrinsville/Te Aroha Dressage Group or the Waikato Combined Equestrian Group are eligible, points will be taken from the date membership is paid for the 2019/2020 season. If you are a member of one of the above groups your points will automatically be entered, and running totals will be available on each of the group's websites.

Riders competing at each show gain points for each placing received, which will be collated by the central administrator. Riders that ride in two or more levels at the same or separate show (horse/rider combination), will accumulate points in each individual level (not combined). If points have been accumulated in more than one level at the end of the season the highest amount of points in that particular category will be used. If horse/rider combination rides 3 tests in a day points will be taken from two of the tests in the same level.

In the event of a tie the winner will be decided by the highest average percentage gained across all of the competitions. Champion, Reserve and 3rd place getters in each grade will be presented with Medals and Rosettes at the Dressage Waikato AGM – winners must be present to receive awards.
